

- Mental and Physical aspects of Global QoL assessment significantly increased in both partial and total fundoplication
- Immediate and marked improvement in Reflux, Abdominal pain and Indigestion
- Maintained over 5 years



# 25 Years of the GERD-HRQL symptom severity instrument: an assessment of published applications

Vic Velanovich 1

- •Total of 767 articles by 562 different first authors in 193 different journals from 53 countries
- Baseline scores highest for GERD and LPR
- Lowest for Barrett's, Obesity, and ENT disorders
- •GERD-HRQL is a good assessment of Surgical and Endoscopic treatment success for typical GERD symptoms
- •Success usually 50% reduction in score after treatment






### Longitudinal comparison of quality of life in patients undergoing laparoscopic Toupet fundoplication versus magnetic sphincter augmentation



## Quality of life after giant hiatus hernia repair: A systematic review

Akshay R Date <sup>1</sup>, Yan Mei Goh <sup>2</sup>, Yan Li Goh <sup>3</sup>, Ilayaraja Rajendran <sup>4</sup>, Ravindra S Date <sup>5</sup>

- •29 studies evaluated quality of life pre and post surgery in patients with >50% of their stomach in the chest
- 22 of these studies reported excellent or good post operatively in at least 83% of patients
- Mean follow up of 22 months
- These papers even support repair in patients 70 yrs and older







